

SOCIAL NETWORKING can be dangerous. What parents can do to keep their child safe.



- Talk to your child about online safety and privacy.
- Create family internet and texting rules.
- Make the account private.
- PARENTS: Be aware of what's happening.
- Be a friend on your child's page.
- Keep the computer in a public location.
- Consider some type of filtering system.
- Make sure the "Remember Me" box remains unchecked.
- Read the policies before joining a SNS. Most people just click 'Agree' and move on.

However, by selecting this option you are agreeing that all the following information is correct:

- E-mail address
 - First name
 - Last name
 - Country
 - Postal Code
 - Gender
 - Date of birth
- Postal Codes - Postal Codes are displayed next to your profile page. Therefore, it is viewed by everyone who visits your page. Select a different country or a zip code that is hundreds of miles away.
 - Think twice about posting photos.
 - Check comments regularly.
 - Limit screen time.
 - Set guidelines for friends.
 - Turn off texting devices during family time.

Lastly, remember that all information posted on the www is PERMANENT!
